

Use with cold water only.

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Prior to using AquaSorb LS 1.05 Ag, the material requires an initial rinse to remove carbon dust and fines and to properly wet the material. The rinse should be accomplished by ensuring that one unit volume of material is fully submerged in three unit volumes of tap water for a period of no less than 15 minutes and no more than 20 minutes, following which the material should be left to drain.

Proper personnel protective equipment including gloves and dust mask should be utilized when handling AquaSorb LS 1.05 Ag. Virgin and spent AquaSorb LS 1.05 Ag should be disposed of in an environmentally acceptable manner.

This product is only to be used for manufacturing or fabricating bacteriostatic filters which are used to remove objectionable taste, odor, color, and suspended particles from the municipally treated tap water. Manufacturers or formulators must inform users of the replacement use life of their product, and stipulate that the water filter unit is to only be used with the cold line/cold tap water.
