b. Delete the claim, "Kills 99.9% of bacteria" and state "This product is effective against Staphylococcus aureus, Pseudomonas aeruginosa, and Salmonella enterica."

- c. Qualify tiled walls as hard nonporous by stating "glazed tiled walls."
- d. Revise the "Suitable for Kitchens" and "Suitable for Bathrooms" phrase to read "Suitable for use in Kitchens on...." and "Suitable for use in Bathrooms on...."
- e. Delete the "other uses" children's room and pet areas because it is too broad. You must list specific hard nonporous surfaces common to these use sites.
- f. Revise the phrase "Not recommended for use..." to read "Do not use on ..."
- g. Revise the second statement under the "Precautionary Statements" to read "Avoid contact with eyes, skin, or clothing." Delete the third statement because it is repetitive.
- h. According to PR Notice 20001-1, First Aid Statements must be organized so that the most severe routes of exposure as determined by the toxicity classification are listed first. According to the acute toxicology profile, the First Aid Statements must be listed in the following order: IF ON SKIN, IF IN EYES, IF SWALLOWED.
- i. Since this product is sold in containers one gallon or less, revise the "Storage and Disposal" statements to be in compliance with PR Notice 84-1 and Label Manual, 2nd Edition by reading as follows:

Storage and Disposal: Store product in original container in a cool, dry place. Keep containers tightly closed. Do not flush. Do not reuse empty container. Dispose of wipes and container in the trash.

3. Submit three (3) copies of your final printed labeling before distributing or selling the product bearing the revised labeling.

If these conditions are not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA sec. 6(e). Your release for shipment of the product constitutes acceptance of these conditions.
