DIRECTIONS FOR USE:

It is a violation of Federal to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Use Copper Amine C9 to control all types of fungal decay of wood products - brown, white, and soft rot and wood-eating insects including termites. Copper Amine C9 should be used to treat any wood product that will be exposed to conditions favorable to rot, decay, or insect attack both above ground and in ground or water. Types of products include lumber, timbers, landscape ties, fence posts, building and utility poles, land, freshwater and marine piling, sea walls, decking and wood shingles. Tank mix Copper Amine C9 with quaternary ammonium compounds, triazoles, or other co-biocides approved by the EPA. Do not attempt to use without having the necessary safety equipment. Apply the tank-mixed solution where the water solutions will have concentrations ranging from 0.3 to 3.0 percent active ingredients by weight. The treatment of wood products with this Copper Amine C9 wood preservative provides wood with protection against termites, ascomycetes, white rot, brown rot, and dry rot. A 3% solution can be used to field coat the cut ends of pressure treated wood by brush-on application.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL:

Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage or disposal. Open dumping is prohibited. Do not reuse empty container.

PESTICIDE DISPOSAL: For containers 5 gallons Pesticide wastes are acutely hazardous. Improper disposal of excess pesticide, spray mixture, or rinsate is a violation of Federal Law. If these wastes cannot be disposed of by use according to label instructions contact your State Pesticide or Environmental Control Agency, or the Hazardous Waste representative at the nearest EPA Regional Office for guidance. Triple rinse as follows: Empty remaining contents into application equipment or a mix tank. Fill the container 1/4 full withwater. Replace and tighten closures. Tip container on its side and roll it back and forth, ensuring at least one complete revolution, for 30 seconds. Stand the container on its end and tip it back and forth several times. Turn the container over onto its other end and tip it back and forth several times. Empty the rinsate into application equipment or a mix tank or store rinsate for later use or disposal. Repeat this procedure two more times.

If these wastes cannot be disposed of by use according to label instructions contact your State Pesticide or Environmental Control Agency, or the Hazardous Waste representative at the nearest EPA Regional Office for guidance. Triple rinse as follows: Empty remaining contents into application equipment or a mix tank and drain for 10 seconds after the flow begins to drip. Fill the container ¼ full with water and recap. Shake for 10 seconds. Pour rinsate into application equipment or a mix tank or store rinsate for later use or disposal. Drain for 10 seconds after the flow begins to drip. Repeat this procedure two more times.

CONTAINER DISPOSAL:

(5 gallons or less)

Nonrefillable Container. Do not refill or reuse this container. Triple rinse as follows: Fill container ¼ full with water. Shake for 10 seconds. Empty the rinsate into the application equipment or mix tank or store rinsate for later use or disposal. Repeat this procedure two more times. Then offer for recycling or reconditioning. If not available, puncture and dispose in a sanitary landfill.

(5 gallons or more)

Nonrefillable Container. Do not refill or reuse container. Triple rinse as follows: Fill container ¼ full with water. Tip container on its side and roll it back and forth, ensuring at least one complete revolution for 30 seconds. Stand the container on its end and tip it back and forth several times. Turn the container over onto its other end and tip it back and forth several times. Empty the rinsate into the application equipment or mix tank or store rinsate for later use or disposal. Repeat this procedure two more times. Then offer for recycling or reconditioning. If not available, puncture and dispose in a sanitary landfill.
