DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling. Do not apply this product in a way that will contact workers or other persons, either directly or through drift. Only protected handlers may be in the area during application.

This product has been developed to be used for treatment of wood products. This product can be used in tank mixes with azole compounds, quaternary ammonium, or other compounds approved for wood treatment. Observe the most restrictive of the labeling limitations and precautions of all products used in mixtures. Do not attempt to use without reading the manual and having the necessary safety equipment. To be used only in treatment of wood products utilizing water solutions having concentrations ranging from 0.005 percent to 0.5 percent active ingredients by weight. Impregnation procedures must rigidly adhere to the current specifications of Arch Treatment Technologies, Inc. and/or the American Wood Protection Association.

Processes used to apply formulations shall leave no visible surface deposits on the wood. Visible surface deposits mean a surface residue or crystallization on the treated wood. Small isolated or infrequent spots of chemical on otherwise clean wood shall be allowed. Treatment of wood products with this wood preservative provides wood with protection against termites, Ascomycetes, white rot, brown rot, soft rot, and dry rot. The percent solution to be used should be based on the retention in lbs. per cubic foot (pcf) specified by the purchaser and by the treating process used.

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS

DANGER: Corrosive. Cause skin burns and irreversible eye damage. Do not get in eyes, on skin or on clothing. Harmful if swallowed or inhaled. Avoid breathing spray mist. USER SAFETY RECOMMENDATIONS

Users should wash hands before eating, drinking, chewing gum, using tobacco, or using the toilet. Users should remove clothing/PPE immediately if pesticide gets inside, then wash thoroughly and put on clean clothing. Users should remove PPE immediately after handling this product. Wash outside of gloves before removing. As soon as possible, wash thoroughly and change into clean clothing.

ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS

This product is toxic to fish and shrimp. Do not apply directly to water. Do not contaminate water when disposing of equipment washwaters or rinsate. Do not discharge effluent containing this product into lakes, streams, ponds, estuaries, oceans or other waters unless in accordance with the requirements of a National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) permit and the permitting authority has been notified in writing prior to discharge. Do not discharge effluent containing this product to sewer systems without previously notifying the local sewage treatment plant authority. STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage or disposal.

CONTAINER HANDLING:

Nonrefillable Container. Do not refill or reuse this container.

{For containers ≤ 5 gallons} Triple rinse as follows: Fill container $\frac{1}{4}$ full with water. Shake for 10 seconds. Empty the rinsate into the application equipment or a mix tank or store rinsate for later use or disposal. Repeat this procedure two more times. Then offer for recycling or reconditioning. If not available, puncture and dispose in a sanitary landfill.

{For containers > 5 gallons} Triple rinse as follows: Fill container ¼ full with water. Tip container on its side and roll it back and forth, ensuring at least one complete revolution for 30 seconds. Stand the container on its end and tip it back and forth several times. Turn the container over onto its other end and tip it back and forth several times. Empty the rinsate into application equipment or mix tank or store rinsate for later use or disposal. Repeat this procedure two more times. Then offer for recycling or reconditioning. If not available, puncture and dispose in a sanitary landfill.
