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Sani-Spa Tablet has been formulated to aid in the reduction of contamination in foot massage and foot spa bath water at salons, spas and beauty parlors. When used as directed, **Sani-Spa Tablet** will sanitize pedicure foot spa bath, foot massage bath and portable foot spa bath water to keep it clean and clear. This product contains a biocide, a water softener and a pH balancer, all in one tablet. The biocide sanitizes foot spa bath water. The water softener chemically balance the calcium hardness and total alkalinity and pH balancer adjusts the pH to 7.2 - 7.8.

Sani-Spa Tablet:

- delivers sanitizing and cleaning performance in pedicure foot spa water, foot massage bath water and portable foot bath water.
- is effective yet economical.
- cleans and sanitizes in one labor saving step.
- is formulated for use in daily maintenance programs with a balance of detergents and biocides that deliver effective cleaning and sanitizing action.
- is a complete, chemically-balanced sanitizer and fungicide [fungistat].

Use Sani-Spa Tablet:

- as a sanitizer for pedicure foot spa water, foot massage bath water and portable foot bath water.
- to clean and sanitize pedicure foot spa water, foot massage bath water and portable foot bath water.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Before Use By Each Customer:

1. Fill one quarter (1 - 1.25 gallons) of the total capacity of the foot spa bath with warm water.
2. Add one tablet to the foot spa bath water and agitate to dissolve. One tablet in 1 - 1.25 gallons of foot spa bath water will provide an active bromine concentration of 40 ppm.
3. Circulate the water in the foot spa bath for ten minutes.
4. Add enough warm water to fill the foot spa bath to full capacity (4 - 5 gallons). The active bromine concentration during customer use is 10 ppm.

After Use By Each Customer: before putting feet in.

1. All water must be drained and all debris removed from the foot spa bath basin.
2. Thoroughly clean foot spa bath basin with soap and water.
3. Follow all additional manufacturer's recommendations and all state requirements concerning cleaning and disinfection of foot spa bath equipment.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage or disposal.

PESTICIDE STORAGE: Store in original container in areas inaccessible to children. Store at temperatures less than 100 °F. Do not store in direct sunlight. Do not store on side. Avoid creasing or impacting of side walls. Do not reuse empty container. Discard in trash or recycle.

PESTICIDE DISPOSAL: COMMERCIAL: Wastes resulting from the use of this product may be disposed of on site or at an approved waste disposal facility.

CONTAINER DISPOSAL: FIBER DRUMS: Completely empty liner by shaking and tapping sides and bottom to loosen clinging particles. Empty residue into application equipment. Then dispose of liner in sanitary landfill or by incineration if allowed by State and local authorities.
