

2. Make the following label changes:

- a. Revise the EPA Registration Number to read, EPA Reg. No. 75583-1
- b. Modify the Ingredients Statement, per the DEET RED, to read:

Other Ingredients.....79.08%
- c. Modify the EPA Establishment number to reflect the manufacturer of this product.
- d. Modify the statement "WARNING: read cautions on back" to read "WARNING: see first aid statements on side."
- e. Under Precautionary Statements, place the signal word "WARNING" alone on a line.
- f. Display each of the subheadings "Storage", "Disposal", and Physical/Chemical Hazards" alone on a line with the appropriate directions or information immediately under the subheadings.

g. Revise the first aid statements as follows, per PR Notice 2001-1:

1.) IF IN EYES:

- Hold open and rinse slowly and gently with water for 15 -20 minutes. Remove contact lenses, if present, after the first 5 minutes, then continue rinsing eye.
- Call poison control center or doctor for further treatment advice.

2.) Other first aid statements are not required, but if included are to read exactly as they appear in PR Notice 2001-1 (p.8).

h. The following statements must be on all DEET end use product labels (see DEET RED).

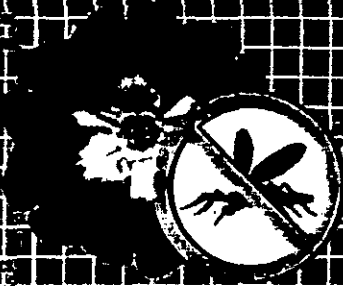
