- 1. In the statement of ingredients, footnote "Mineral Oil" with a statement that reads "Contains petroleum distillates".
2. Under "FIRST AID", change the heading "IF ON SKIN" to "IF ON SKIN OR CLOTHING".

3. Change the order of treatments listed under "**FIRST AID**" to:

IF ON SKIN OR CLOTHING ...
IF SWALLOWED ...
IF IN EYES ...
IF INHALED ...

4. To the "**FIRST AID**" table, insert a new table-wide cell between the "IF INHALED" row and the "NOTE TO PHYSICIAN". Move the sentence "Have the product container or label with you ... for treatment" from the "NOTE TO PHYSICIAN:" to the new table-wide cell.

That sentence should be followed by the sentence "You also may contact 1-800-xxx-xxxx for emergency medical treatment information." You are responsible for identifying and inserting the appropriate telephone number.

5. To the end of the "**CAUTION**" paragraph ("Harmful if swallowed ... before reuse"), add the following sentence:

Prolonged or frequently repeated skin contact may cause allergic reactions in some individuals.

6. In the "**DIRECTIONS FOR USE**" section, delete "**(such as)**" from the place where it now appears.

7. Delete "application equipment or a" from the fourth sentence of the "CONTAINER DISPOSAL:" paragraph in the "**STORAGE AND DISPOSAL**" box.

Between the eighth ("Stand the container ... times") and ninth ("Empty the rinsate ... disposal") sentences of this paragraph, insert the following sentence: "Turn the container over onto its other end and tip it back and forth several times."

Replace the ninth sentence with "Collect the rinsate for proper disposal."

8. The label must indicate the net contents of the container and the batch number that it contains.

Products shipped after 12 months from the date of this Notice or the next printing of your label, which ever occurs first, must bear the new revised label. Submit one copy of the final printed label before shipping this product bearing the new revised label.

The Confidential Statement of Formula (CSF) dated "8/15/2008" is accepted and replaces all CSFs previously accepted for this product.

A copy of the stamped accepted label is enclosed.

2. This product may be used to formulate products for specific uses not listed on this manufacturing-use product label if the formulator, user group, or grower has complied with the U.S. EPA submission requirements regarding support of such uses.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal.

PESTICIDE STORAGE: Keep away from heat, sparks or open flame. Keep container closed when not in use.

PESTICIDE DISPOSAL: Wastes resulting from the use of this product must be disposed of on site or at an approved waste disposal facility.

CONTAINER DISPOSAL: (55 gallon) Nonrefillable container. Do not reuse or refill this container. Triple rinse (or equivalent) promptly after emptying. Triple rinse as follows: Empty the remaining contents into the application equipment or a mix tank. Fill the container 1/4 full with water. Replace and tighten closures. Tip container on its side and roll it back and forth, ensuring at least one complete revolution, for 30 seconds. Stand the container on its end and tip it back and forth several times. Empty the rinsate into application equipment or a mix tank or store rinsate for later use or disposal. Repeat this procedure two more times. Then offer for recycling, if available, or puncture or dispose of in a sanitary landfill, or by incineration. Do not burn unless allowed by state and local ordinances.
