DIRECTIONS FOR USE

FOR PROFESSIONAL USE ONLY

A general-purpose cleaner for use in self contained dental unit water line systems. Use only in combination with H₂Pro Clean Start Bottle A (EPA Reg. No. 75829-1).

INITIAL TREATMENT

Pour entire contents of both H₂Pro Clean Start Bottles A and B into empty dental chair water bottle.

Run all lines attached to the dental chair until red coloration appears exiting the lines. Allow lines to sit unused for a minimum of 12 hours.

Prior to chair use completely drain remaining Clean Start Treatment solution from the dental chair reservoir. Prepare and use H₂Pro Maintenance Treatment (alternate formula of EPA Reg. No. 75829-1) according to Maintenance Treatment directions.
