With respect to the labeling, we have the following comments:

1. Under the "Horse Barns, Stables, Stalls and Trailers" section of the label, your label states that the user should "Repeat treatment as necessary but not more than once per week." Please explain why you should spray once per week if necessary when your label claims that your product will continue to work for up to 16 weeks after spraying. Either delete this statement or indicate a time for retreatment based upon the residual efficacy of your product.
2. Under the "Wasps, Hornets, Yellow Jackets and Bees" sections, please add the following statement: "Do not spray flying insects."
3. Due to outdoor uses, please add the bee warning statement.
4. Add the following precaution to the first paragraph under Outdoors "Remove all exposed food and cooking utensils. Cover all food handling surfaces or wash thoroughly after treatment and before use. Do not use on edible crops."

Please submit two (2) copies of your final printed label for before your release the product for shipment. Please refer to the A-79 enclosure for a further description of final printed labeling. If these conditions are not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA section 6(e). Your release for shipment of the product bearing amended labeling constitutes acceptance of these conditions. A stamped copy of the label is enclosed for your records. **GENERAL INFORMATION**

Hold container upright. Do not spray up into air. Apply to surfaces as a spot and crack & crevice treatment. Turn sprayer nozzle to "on" position. Hold approximately 12 inches from surface to be sprayed. Squeeze trigger to spray until surface is slightly moist but not to the point of runoff.

**HORSE BARN, STABLES, STALLS AND TRAILERS**

Insects coming to rest on treated surfaces will be killed or repelled.. Repeat treatment as necessary but not more than once per week. Insects coming to rest on treated surfaces will be killed.

**Wasps, Hornets, Yellow Jackets and Bees:** Spray nests and other surfaces where bees may rest. Aim spray at nest openings. Applications should be made late in the evening when insects are at rest.
