This product is conditionally registered in accordance with FIFRA sec. 3(c)(7)(a) provided that:

- 1. Submit and/or cite all data required for registration of your product under FIFRA Section 3(c)(5) when the Agency requires all registrants of similar products to submit such data, and submit acceptable responses required for reregistration of your product under FIFRA section 4.
- 2. Move the First Aid statements from page 9 to the Front Panel of the label, as noted in the Label Review Manual, because no rationale was provided as to why these statements need to be located on the back panel.
- 3. Remove all reference to and directions for use against Termites, Carpenter Bees, and Bed Bugs. Data were neither cited, nor submitted to support claims against these pests.
- 4. On page 1, in the list of optional marketing claims, modify the following claims as indicated:
 - "Controls Ants, Fire Ants, Fleas, Ticks, Termites (Localized Control Only) and More" to read "Controls Ants, Fire Ants, Fleas, and More Insects, as Listed"
 - Change "Controls Many Different Insect Pests" to "Controls Many Different Listed Insect Pests"

- Change "XX% more vs. XX% size" to read "XX% more vs. XX (lb)(oz)(kg)(g) size"
- 5. On page 4 under Ornamental Plant Pests, put a comma between "Holly" and "Rose midges."
- 6. On page 5 under the Remarks section for sweet corn, add "in" between the application rate and "one."
- 7. On page 8 under Precautionary Statements, update the "wash thoroughly..." statement to read as follows:
 - "Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling and before eating, drinking, chewing gum, using tobacco or using the toilet."
- 8. Revise the EPA Registration Number to read: "EPA Registration No. 79529-32" on page 1 of the label.

Two copies of the finished labeling must be submitted prior to releasing the product for shipment. If these conditions are not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA sec. 6(e). Your release for shipment of the product constitutes acceptance of these conditions. A copy of your label stamped "Accepted with Comments" is enclosed for your records.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Black Flag Insecticide Dust is a ready-to-use insecticide dust that provides effective knockdown and long-lasting control of listed pests [when used according to label directions].

Black Flag Insecticide Dust provides long-lasting pest control in and around homes including animal quarters, apartments, houses, household greenhouses, mobile homes and recreational vehicles, ornamentals, and vegetables.

This product should be applied with a hand duster, shaker can, or a paint brush to areas where listed insects are found.

Application is prohibited directly into sewer drains, or to any area like a gutter where drainage to sewers, storm drains, water bodies, or aquatic habitat can occur. Do not allow the product to enter any drain during or after application.

INDOOR USE

Ants, Boxelder Bugs, Centipedes, Cockroaches, Crickets, Fleas, Firebrats, Ground Beetles, Millipedes, Scorpions, Silverfish, Sowbugs, and Spiders:

Apply directly into cracks and crevices, along baseboards, in attics and crawl spaces, wall voids, around electrical outlets, around water and sewer pipes, under and behind cabinets; refrigerators and sinks; around windows and door frames. Apply lightly and uniformly to infested area using .5 lbs per 1000 sq. ft. Do not apply up in the air or apply in mounds on exposed surfaces. To avoid the possibility of staining, do not use on carpets, upholstery and other fabrics. Do not apply as a broadcast application indoors.

For Ants, apply to ant trails, around doors and windows and other places where ants enter premises.

Termites, Carpenter Ants and Carpenter Bees: Apply to voids or channels in damaged wood of a structure including cracks, spaces or bearing joints between wooden members of a structure; between such members and the foundation; and in locations vulnerable to termite attack. Drilling may be necessary prior to treating these locations, but treatment may not result in complete coverage of infested and vulnerable voids or galleries. Attics and crawl spaces can be treated for drywood and Formosan termites at 0.5 lb. per 1000 square feet of floor area. During treatment, all vents and blowers should be closed. Inspect at 6 months and one year to ensure that colony has been killed. For active termite infestations, contact a professional pest control operator for a thorough inspection and treatment plan.

Carpenter Ants: To control carpenter ants up to one year [12 months], apply dust into wall voids through existing openings or by drilling a small hole. Insert end of a puff duster into opening and squeeze container to apply approximately 0.07 lbs/100 sq. ft. of dust per wall void. Reseal hole after treatment. Nests in wall voids can be located by listening for insect activity against the wall.

Webbing Clothes Moths: Use Black Flag Insecticide Dust as a crack and crevice treatment in closets and other storage areas where these pests are found. Moth larvae already on the clothes will not be controlled. DO NOT apply this product directly to clothing.

Carpet Beetles (Black, Furniture, Common and Varied): Dust where these insects are found, for example: under edges of floor coverings, behind baseboards, under rugs and furniture, and in closets. Do not apply directly to carpeting.

Bedbugs: Apply to crack and crevices where bedbug activity is found. Treat bed frames, box springs, inside empty dressers and clothes closets, carpet edges, high and low wall moldings, and wall paper edges. Do NOT use on mattresses, pillows, bed linens, or clothes. Remove all clothes and other articles from dressers or clothes closets before application. Not recommended for use as sole protection against bedbugs, If evidence of bedbugs is found in or on mattresses, use products approved for this use.

STORED PRODUCT PESTS:

To aid in the control of the exposed stages of cadelles, merchant grain beetles, cheese mites, red flour beetles, cigarette beetles, rice weevils, confused flour beetles, rusty grain beetles, dark meal worms, saw-toothed grain beetles, drugstore beetles, spider beetles, grain mites, tobacco moths, granary weevils, yellow meal worms, lesser grain borers:

Cover all food processing surfaces and utensils during treatment or thoroughly wash before use. Remove or cover exposed food.

Thoroughly treat floors, walls and other surfaces in storage and handling areas. Apply dust in cracks and crevices, behind and under cupboards, and other areas where insects may hide. DO NOT apply directly on food, utensils or other areas where food is stored. Discard all infested food.

OUTDOOR USE

Do not water the treated area to the point of run-off. Do not make applications during rain.

ORNAMENTAL PLANT PESTS

For the control of aphids, leafrollers, beet armyworms, orange tortrix, blister beetles, periodical cicada, boxelder bugs, plant bugs, certain leafminers (Boxwood, Holly rose midges, Oak, Spruce Needle), rose chafer, rose slugs, elm leaf beetle, tent caterpillars, flea beetles, thrips, Japanese beetles, weevils, leafhoppers:

SHRUBS, ROSES, PETUNIAS, CHRYSANTHEMUMS, GERANIUMS, CARNATIONS AND OTHER F LOWERS AND ORNAMENTALS: Apply a light dust to cover both upper and lower sides of leaves, stems, and flowers when insects or their damage first appear. Repeat at weekly intervals if necessary.

PERIMETER TREATMENT

Ants, Bees, Centipedes, Cockroaches, Crickets, Firebrats, Fleas, Ground Beetles, Millipedes, Scorpions, Silverfish, Slugs, Sowbugs, Spiders, Ticks and Wasps: Apply at .5 lbs per 1000 sq ft. for long-lasting control around windows and doors, porches, screens, eaves, patios, garages, under stairways, in crawl spaces, and along the foundation to help prevent pests from entering the home.

HOME VEGETABLE GARDENS

Use a dust applicator such as a shaker can, dust gun, puffer or other bulbous duster, rotary duster or other appropriate available duster. Dust lightly to cover both upper and lower leaf surfaces [with a thin, even film of dust]. Apply when air is calm to avoid drift and contact with eyes and skin. Start applying at the farthest corner of the treatment area and work backward to avoid contact with dusted surfaces. Allow dust to settle in treated areas before reentering.

RED IMPORTED FIRE ANT MOUND TREATMENT:

Sprinkle one tablespoon (TBS) of dust over the top of each mound or apply with a shaker can. Evenly [thoroughly] apply dust to adequately cover mound and around the perimeter (18" from the outer edge of the mound). DO NOT WATER IN OR DISTURB THE MOUND AFTER APPLICATION. Treat all colonies in the vicinity. Apply when temperatures are between 65 and 80°F. Allow 3 to 4 days for maximum control, then repeat as necessary. Do not use food utensils, such as a teaspoon or measuring cups, for food after use with pesticides.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Storage: Store product in original container in a cool, dry, locked place out of the reach of children. **Disposal:** Nonrefillable container. **If empty:** Do not reuse or refill this container. Place in trash or offer for recycling if available.
