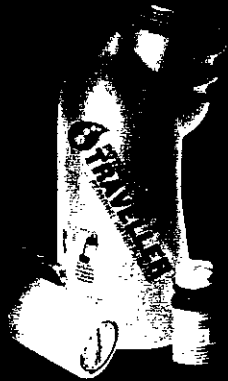

Potable Aqua® is for use only when drinking water is suspected or known to be bacteriologically substandard. Not to be used on a continuous basis for short term or limited emergency use only.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Store in a cool, dry place. Do not reuse container. Offer for recycling if available. **PARTLY FILLED:** Call your local health agency for disposal instructions.
