- 3. Long Lasting Protection
- 4. Repels Mosquitoes that may transmit West Nile Virus.
- 5. Protects [for] up to 10 hours.


# **DIRECTIONS FOR USE:**

Do not apply near eyes and mouth. Apply sparingly around ears. Do not apply over cuts, wounds or irritated skin. Do not allow children to handle this product. Do not apply to children's hands. When using on children, apply to your own hands, and then put it on the child. Use just enough repellent to cover exposed skin and/or clothing. Do not use under clothing. Avoid over-application of this product. After returning indoors, wash treated skin with soap and water. Wash treated clothing before wearing it again. Do not spray in enclosed areas. If used on the face, spray on hands first and then apply sparingly and avoid eyes. Do not spray directly onto face. To avoid damage, do not apply to acetate, rayon, spandex, furniture finishes, leather, plastics, painted or varnished surfaces, watch crystals, guns, bows, automobiles.
