The revised Confidential Statement of Formula dated July 30th, 2004, is acceptable.


3. Submit two copies of the revised final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment.

AQUASTAT-XR is to be used to protect the water filter itself against growth of bacteria and mold and to prevent odors and unpleasant tastes or discoloration.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage and disposal.

- Pesticide Storage:** Do not store in areas accessible to children. Keep product dry and containers covered during storage.
- Pesticide Disposal:** Wastes from the use of this product may be disposed of on site or at an approved waste disposal facility
