In support of this submission I have enclosed the following documents:

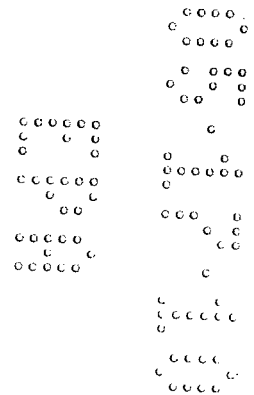

DIRECTIONS FOR USE:

ICX® is intended for use in general dental applications by providing water to the dental syringe, various handpiece ancillary devices, and cuspidor cupfill. When used according to these instructions for every bottle refill, optimum efficacy for control of odor and foul taste bacteria can be achieved.

1. Empty any remaining water left in the bottle.
2. Drop tablet into an empty dental unit water bottle (0.7L tablet in 0.7 liter bottle, 2 L tablet in 2 liter). Avoid touching the tablet with unprotected skin.
3. Fill bottle with water and connect to the dental unit.
4. Wait 120 seconds for the tablet to fully dissolve.

NOTE -This product is intended for use with potable water and in conjunction with regular dental unit water testing.

FIRST AID:

If solid product gets in eyes, hold eye open and rinse slowly and gently with water 15 to 20 minutes. Remove contact lenses, if present, after the first five minutes, then continue rinsing.
