b. As per the submitted and cited acute toxicity studies, the signal word for this product is DANGER. Revise your label to include the signal word "DANGER." In addition, revise your Precautionary Statements to be in agreement with these studies as follows:

"Corrosive. Causes irreversible eye damage. Harmful if swallowed. Do not get in eyes or on clothing. Wear goggles, face shield or safety glasses. Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling and before eating, drinking, chewing gum, using tobacco or using the toilet. Remove and wash contaminated clothing before reuse."

c. Revise your First Aid statements to be in agreement with the acute toxicity studies by replacing the proposed language with the following statements:

"If in Eyes:

- Hold eye open and rinse slowly and gently with water for 15-20 minutes.
- Remove contact lenses, if present, after the first 5 minutes, then continue rinsing eye.
- Call a Poison Control Center or doctor for treatment advice.

If Swallowed:

- Call a Poison Control Center or doctor immediately for treatment advice.
- Have person sip a glass of water if able to swallow.
- Do not induce vomiting unless told to do so by a Poison Control Center or doctor.
- Do not give anything by mouth to an unconscious person.

Note to Physician: Probable mucosal damage may contraindicate the use of gastric lavage.

- d. Revise the first section of your directions for use to include the following clarification: "Add 1 part F10CL to 49 parts water."
- e. Correct the directions for use to by indicating the correct ounces per gallon needed for the use solution. Revise to state **2.6 ounces per gallon of water**. Make this correction twice in the Directions for Use section.

f. Revise the Container Handling section by correcting the Container Disposal statement to bring this label into agreement with PR Notice 2007-4. Revise to include the following language: "...Fill container ¼ full with water and recap. Shake for 10 seconds. Drain for 10 seconds after flow begins to drip. Store rinsate for later disposal. Repeat procedure two more times..."

Directions for Use

It is a violation of federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling. This product is effective against Pseudomonas aeruginosa (ATCC15442), Salmonella enterica (ATCC 10708), and Staphylococcus aureus (ATCC 6538) on hard nonporous surfaces when used at 1:50 use solution for a contact time of 10 minutes.

Remove all animals and feed from premises, vehicles, and enclosures Remove all litter and manure from floors, walls, and surfaces of barns, pens, stalls, chutes, and other facilities and fixtures occupied or traversed by animals

Empty all troughs, racks, automatic feeders, waterers, and other feeding and watering appliances.

Thoroughly clean all surfaces with soap or detergent and rinse with water. Saturate all surfaces with use solution (2.6 oz per gallon of water) for a period of 10 minutes.

Immerse all halters, ropes, and other types of equipment used in handling and restraining animals as well as forks, shovels, and scrapers used in removing litter and manure.

Ventilate buildings, vehicles, and other closed spaces. Do not house animals or employ equipment until treatment has been absorbed, set, or dried. Thoroughly scrub all treated feed racks, automatic feeders, waterers, and other feeding and watering appliances with soap or detergent, and rinse with water before reuse.

Clear away debris, clean and pre-rinse with water. Prepare a solution by mixing 1 part F10CL Veterinary Disinfectant with 49 parts of clean water (2.436 oz per gallon).

Apply to surface as a wash, or through a foamer or spray device. Wet all surfaces thoroughly and leave for a contact time of at least 10 minutes. Reapply as necessary to ensure the surface remains wet for the entire 10 minute contact time. Leave to air dry.

Fill container ¼ full with water and recap. Shake for 10 seconds. Pour rinsate into application equipment or mix tank or store rinsate for later use or disposal. Drain for 10 seconds after the flow begins to drip. Repeat procedure two more times. Then offer for recycling or reconditioning. If not available, puncture and dispose in a sanitary landfill.

Spills and leakage

Soak up on an inert material e.g. dry earth and dispose of in an approved site. Flush small amounts with copious amounts of water.
