b. Revise the Precautionary Statements to read as follows:



**Directions for use**

It is a violation of federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with this labeling.

Place unit in pump basket or skimmer allowing good water flow over it. The minerals will dissolve out of the unit into the pool eliminating the algae. The Minerals need to be replaced every 3 to 6 months or whenever you see a re-growth of Algae

Replace the unit at the beginning of each swim season, if your pool is bigger than 20,000 gallons additional minerals will be needed, 1 booster per 10,000 gallons.

Low chlorine residual is still essential for a properly sanitized pool.  
Minimum 0.5 to 1.00 ppm

**Do not use Bromine or Biguanides with this product**
