DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with the labeling.

Reentry into treated swimming pools/spas is prohibited above levels of 3.0 ppm.

TRICHLOR Chlorinating Tablets are to be used as a disinfectant and algae control in pool water. They are long-lasting and are intended to slowly meter chlorine into pool water in order to receive its maximum affect use as follows:

1. Superchlorinate the pool water with a fast acting shock treatment or other chlorinating product. Follow label directions for these products. Do not enter pool until the chlorine residual drop to 2.0 ppm (part per million).

2. Using chlorine stabilizer, adjust the cyanuric acid level in pool water to 3.5 ppm, following labeling directions.

3. Adjust the pH. to the ideal range to 7.2 to 7.8 with pH. Plus if the pH is below 7.2 or pH Minus if the pH is above 7.8.

4. Add one TRICHLOR chlorinating tablet per 10,000 gallons of pool water into floating dispenser every week, or as needed as determined by a chlorine test kit to maintain a 1.0 to 1.5 ppm (parts per million) residual chlorine. Check water for chlorine content at regular intervals. During extreme heat or with heavy bather loads, water should be checked every 2 hours. Maintain a pH level of 7.2 to 7.6 for best results.

One (1) TRICHLOR chlorinating tablet weighs approximately 7 oz. (200 grams) and WILL LAST APPROXIMATELY ONE WEEK DEPENDING ON TEMPERATURE, BATHER LOAD AND AMOUNT OF WATER FLOW. Tabs should never be thrown directly into pool as they may cause spotting or bleaching. Not recommended for splasher or wader pools.
