The amendment referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under section (3) of the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA) is acceptable provided the following studies are submitted:

**Storage stability (OPPTS Guideline 860.1380)**

1. 1,2,4-triazole, triazolyl alanine, and triazolyl acetic acid in strawberry (516 days), due June 1, 2014
2. 1,2,4-triazole, triazolyl alanine, and triazolyl acetic acid in grape (236 days), grape juice (64 days), and raisin (91 days), due June 1, 2014
3. tetraconazole in corn grain, forage, and stover (266 days) , due June 1, 2014
4. 1,2,4-triazole in corn forage and stover (263 days); tetraconazole, due June 1, 2014
5. 1,2,4-triazole, triazolyl alanine, and triazolyl acetic acid in refined corn oil (198 days), due June 1, 2014

**Dislodgeable foliar residues (DFR) (OPPTS Guideline 875.2100)**

1. data for corn grown for seed, due September 1, 2014
