Directions for Applications:

Pre-Application Directions: Before storing, dry-clean, wash, or brush articles to be protected.

Apply the product in clean, airtight containers, bags, and closets at the following rates:

Large Trunk	0.33
50 cu ft (small closet)	1.00

For larger closets the quantity required is estimated as follows:

of pounds required = Height x Width x depth/ 50

For example a closet of 6 feet high, 4 feet wide, and 4 feet deep (i.e., 96 cubic feet) would need about two (2) pounds of product (96/50 = 1.92).

Post-Application Directions:

Keep product in air-tight space for a minimum of seven (7) days. Odor dissipates when treated articles are aired.

Retreatment: Since moths are active year round, replenish airtight containers, bags, and closets twice a year.

USE RESTRICTIONS:

Do not use this naphthalene-containing product with other moth-control chemicals to avoid undesired chemical reactions to damage clothes. Do not use in dry-cleaning bags, garbage bags, closets, or containers that allow vapor to escape into occupied space. Suitable for use on clothes containing wool, wool-blends and others. Not for use to control squirrels bats and birds in the home.
