- D) submit any additional information, data, labeling, and packaging requirements of the September 12, 2008, Naphthalene RED on the same time schedule as other companies subject to the Naphthalene RED. DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Use Restrictions: For control of eggs, larvae, and adults of clothes moths in clean, airtight containers (e.g., chests and trunks), garment bags, and storage closets. Do not use this naphthalene-containing product with other moth-control chemicals to avoid undesired chemical reactions that may damage clothes. Do not use in dry-cleaning bags, garbage bags, closets, or containers that allow vapor to escape into occupied space. Suitable for use on clothes containing wool, wool-blends and others. Do not use to control squirrels bats and birds in the home.

IMPORTANT: Keep out of reach of children. Do not place in areas accessible to children.

Pre-Application Directions: Before storing, dry-clean, wash, or brush articles to be protected.

Applications Directions: Apply the product in clean, airtight containers, bags, and closets at the following rates:

Area of Air-tight Enclosed Space	Pounds of Product	
Average Garment Bag	0.25	
Large Trunk	0.33	
50 cu ft (small closet)	1.00	

For larger closets the quantity required is estimated as follows:

of pounds required = Height x Width x depth/ 50

For example a closet of 6 feet high, 4 feet wide, and 4 feet deep (i.e., 96 cubic feet) would need about two (2) pounds of product (96/50 = 1.92).

Post-Application Directions:

Keep product in air-tight space for a minimum of seven (7) days. Odor dissipates when treated articles are aired.

Retreatment: Since moths are active year round, replenish airtight containers, bags, and closets twice a year.
