

- 2. BAQUACIL [brand name] Automated Dosing System will deliver an initial dose to the pool water to obtain an initial reading of 50 70 ppm.
- 3. After about 24 hours, take a water sample to your Authorized SPLASHES TOO [brand name] Dealer for complete water analysis.

NORMAL POOL MAINTENANCE

- 1. Once a week, check the SPLASHES TOO SANITIZER [brand name] concentration, using the SPLASHES TOO Test Strips [brand name].
