


# AMP21 – Soil Amendment to Extend Wood Life

## PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENT

### CAUTION

May be harmful if swallowed. Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling.

Intended for use where wood is in contact with soil (including but not limited to: fence rows, roadsides, railroad rights of way, and utility rights of way) to delay decay of wooden structures.

### How to Apply

Remove product from the package before application. The product may be applied at any time. For best results, insert one rod of AMP21 for each 6 inch interval around the circumference of the wooden object. Insert to a depth of approximately 3 inches from the ground surface, as close as possible to the wood item.

### Storage and Disposal

Storage: Store away from heat and moisture. Keep container tightly closed and keep package dry.  
Disposal: Product and empty packaging may be disposed of as regular trash.
