### HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS

## DIRECTIONS OF USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

### GENERAL USE RESTRICTIONS

This product is for use only on outdoor structures and surfaces such as brown bark of trees, fences, poles, decks, planters, siding, garbage cans, and furniture and on seeds and bulbs as directed below. Do not use on edible crops, sugaring maple trees, or indoors.

### TO REDUCE CHEWING, GNAWING, LICKING, NIBBLING, AND BITING DAMAGE TO OUTDOOR STRUCTURES AND SURFACES SUCH AS BROWN BARK TREES, FENCES, POLES, DECKS, PLANTERS, SIDING, GARBAGE CANS, AND FURNITURE BY TREE SQUIRRELS, DOGS and CATS:

**USE RESTRICTIONS:** This product may damage painted/stained surfaces, fabrics, and plastics; test a small area first to determine suitability for use. Use at full strength; do not dilute or mix this product with any other chemical. Do not use mist blowers or ultra-low volume application equipment to apply this product. Surfaces to be treated must be dry. For treating garbage cans, first remove droppings and clean with water then spray both the garbage and its container. Do not apply this product on rainy, snowy or windy days, or if precipitation is predicted within the next 24 hours. Do not use this product at temperatures below 32° F or above 90° F.

**APPLICATION DIRECTIONS:** Using a sprayer capable of delivering a coarse droplet spray (such as a tank sprayer) spray all surfaces to the point of runoff, or treat by painting with a brush. Make a second application in 2 – 7 days to improve effectiveness. One gallon of this product will treat 1,000 to 4,000 sq. ft., [Five gallons of this product will treat 5,000 to 20,000 sq. ft.; One-half gallon of this product will treat 500 to 2,000 sq. ft./One quart of this product will treat 250 to 1,000 sq. ft. / One pint of this product will treat 125 to 500 sq. ft.] depending on surface conditions and porosity of items being treated.

### TO REDUCE CONSUMPTION AND DAMAGE TO SEEDS OR BULBS BY TREE SQUIRRELS AND VOLES:

**USE RESTRICTIONS:** This product should not cause damage to plants. However, first test THIS PRODUCT on a few seeds to determine any effects on germination.

**APPLICATION DIRECTIONS:** Using rubber gloves, place seed or bulbs in a plastic or metal container and spray until thoroughly soaked. Allow to dry. Repeat application in areas of high animal pressure. Then plant in normal manner.
