


FIRST AID STATEMENT

• **IF SWALLOWED:** Call a poison control center or doctor immediately for treatment advice. Have person sip a glass of water if able to swallow. Do not induce vomiting unless told to do so by a poison control center or doctor. Do not give anything by mouth to an unconscious person.

• **IF ON SKIN OR ON CLOTHING:** Take off contaminated clothing. Rinse skin immediately with plenty of water for 15-20 minutes. Call a poison control center or doctor for treatment advice.

BATHROOM: For washbasins, mop with 1 gallon of water, mop then rinse with water. Stalls follow above directions. Add to a bowl at night, in the morning before use. strength product.
