PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS

WARNING:

Causes eye, skin, and respiratory tract irritation. Harmful if swallowed. Avoid contact with skin, eyes, or clothing.
Physical-Chemical Hazard. Combustible. Do not use or store near heat or open flame.

FIRST AID

If in Eyes	Hold eye open and rinse slowly and gently with water for 15-20 minutes. Remove contact lenses, if present, after the first 5 minutes, then continue rinsing eye. Call a poison control center or doctor for treatment advice.

NOTE TO PHYSICIAN

INSTRUCTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with labeling.

Thoroughly brush or clean articles to be stored. Use at rate of 1 bag (5 oz.) for each 29 cubic ft. of tightly enclosed space. Distribute IMS Moth Balls evenly around and between the folds of stored articles. Be sure storage space is kept tightly closed at all times and for at least 7 days after protecting with IMS Moth Balls.
