On behalf of IMS Trading, L.L.C. (IMS), The Acta Group, L.L.C. is submitting the accompanying amendment applications for the above-referenced products. amendment applications are submitted in accordance with Pesticide Registration (PR) Notice 98-10, for the addition of one or more fragrances in a formulation. IMS proposes to add, at a concentration of less than onexpercent, cedar and lavender scents to its currently registered formulations as alternate formulations. Material Safety Data Sheets (MSDS) for the fragrances accompany this submission. We have forwarded more detailed, confidential formulation information from the supplier directly to Mr. Kerry Leifer to include in U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) files.

The addition of the fragrances requires a slight adjustment to the nominal active. ingredient conceptration, so that the percentages will add to 100 percent. registration numbers 81433-2 and 81433-3, we are submitting revised basic Confidential Statements of Formula (CSF), as well as alternate CSFs for each of the two fragrances, for a total of six CSFs.

Additionally, for IMS Moth Balls, Reg. No. 81433-2, the registrant proposes to sell the moth balls alternatively as individual balls, packaged in five-, six-, and ten-ounce boxes as currently done, or in paper packets, each containing two balls; the packets would be sold in

same size boxes as the currently registered product. The paper packets are the same as those used in other currently registered products and are intended to facilitate use by consumers. The grouping of the moth balls into two-ball paper packets does not require a change to the application rate. Proposed changes to address the paper packets are included in the enclosed proposed revised labels.

As IMS wishes to continue to sell moth balls with and without the paper packets depending on market demand, and also to sell both the moth balls and moth blocks with and without the fragrances, proposed revisions to the labels for these products are being submitted in a master label format. Proposed alternative language is shown in brackets (e.g., [Lavender Scented Moth Balls], [Cedar Scented Moth Balls]) on the proposed revised labels in the accompanying submission. Proposed changes from the currently approved labels have been made in redline to facilitate EPA's review. A copy of the labels without the redline and including all of the proposed changes are also included in this submission.

Included with this submission are the following:

- EPA forms 8570-1;
- Labels with proposed revisions, five sets of each in redline and one set without redline;
- CSFs for the basic and alternate formulations; and
- MSDSs for the fragrances.

paper packets, which allow the active ingredient to work while protecting you and your clothes from messy flakes or residue.]

Directions for Use

It is a violation of federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with labeling.

Thoroughly brush or clean articles to be stored. Use at rate of [1 box (5 oz) for each 29 cubic feet] [1 box (6 oz) for each 35 cubic feet] [1 box (10 oz) for each 57 cubic feet] of tightly enclosed space.

[Sample Use Rates for Moth Ball Packets:

3 packets	Small storage (3 cu.ft)
12 packets	Average garment bag (12 cu.ft)
15 packets	Large trunk (15 cu.ft)]

[To properly treat larger volumes, the use of additional containers of moth ball packets may be required. Use the recommended amount of moth ball packets to ensure protection of your clothes. Do not remove the moth balls from the packets.]

Distribute IMS Moth Balls evenly around and between the folds of stored articles. Be sure storage space is kept tightly closed at all times and for at least 7 days after protecting with IMS Moth Balls. Replace when moth balls have dissipated.

IMS Moth Balls will not harm the finest woolens, furs, silk, or other fabrics. Pleasant odor quickly vanishes when articles are aired.
