Subject: Amended labeling to add an alternate brand name and make other minor changes
IMS Moth Blocks
EPA Registration No. 81433-3
Submission dated February 24, 2010

The amended labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act, is acceptable with the following comments:

- On page 2, under the directions for use, replace the word "should" with "must" and add the following text so the last statement reads, "Paradichlorobenzene moth blocks must not be mixed or placed in contact with other moth preventive products or chemicals." (The word "should" implies that this restriction is advisory, not mandatory.)

Please be reminded that 40 CFR Part 156.140(a)(4) requires that a batch code, lot number, or other code identifying the batch of the pesticide distributed and sold be placed on non-refillable containers. The code may appear either on the label or durably marked on the container itself. This information can be added by non-notification per PR Notice 98-10.

A stamped copy is enclosed for your records. The alternate brand name "Smart Living Moth Blocks" has been added to our records. Please submit two copies of your final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment. Your release for shipment of the product constitutes acceptance of these conditions. If these conditions are not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA section 6(e). [IMS Moth Blocks] [Smart Living Moth Blocks] provide protection for articles stored in trunks, drawers, boxes, etc. They should be sprinkled or placed on the bottom of a storage space, between the folds and layers of clothes, and on top before securely closing the container.

Back Panel:

Protect in winter and summer and spring and fall.

Directions for Use:

It is a violation of federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with labeling.

IMPORTANT: Keep out of reach of children. Do not place in areas accessible to children.

To Kill Moths: Thoroughly brush or clean articles to be stored. Remove cellophane from the blocks and hang above stored articles in tightly sealed closet garment bag, or storage container. Use one [IMS Moth Block] [Smart Living Moth Block] plastic case for each 36 cubic feet of space. If storage container is opened occasionally, add block or blocks and reseal container.

To Freshen Closets: Just hang in closet after removing all of the cellophane. Pleasant odor quickly vanishes when articles are aired.

Do Not Use in plastic storage box or place in contact with plastic items as paradichlorobenzene damages some plastics.

Paradichlorobenzene should not be mixed or placed in contact with other moth preventive chemicals.

Precautionary Statements

Hazards to Humans and Domestic Animals

WARNING

Causes eye, skin, and respiratory tract irritation. Harmful if swallowed. Avoid contact with skin, eyes, or clothing.
