Revise the "First Aid" statements to read:

If Swallowed:

- Call a poison control center or doctor immediately for treatment advice.
- Have person sip a glass of water if able to swallow.
- Do not induce vomiting unless told to do so by a poison control center or doctor.
- Do not give anything by mouth to an unconscious person.

If On Skin Or Clothing:

- Take off contaminated clothing.
- Rinse skin immediately with plenty of water for 15-20 minutes.
- Call a poison control center or doctor for treatment advice.

If Inhaled:

- Move person to fresh air.
- If person is not breathing, call 911 or an ambulance, then give artificial respiration, preferably mouth-to-mouth if possible.
- Call a poison control or doctor for further treatment advice.

If In Eyes:

- Hold eye open and rinse slowly and gently with water for 15-20 minutes. Remove contact lenses, if present, after the first 5 minutes, then continue rinsing eye.
- Call a poison control center or doctor for treatment advice.

Beneath the "First Aid" statements, include the following information:

"Have the product container or label with you when calling a poison control center or doctor, or going for treatment. You may also contact 1-800-xxx-xxxx (insert number) for emergency medical treatment information."

- e. Add the following statement so that it appears at the end of the First Aid Statements:

"Note To Physician

Probable mucosal damage may contraindicate the use of gastric lavage."

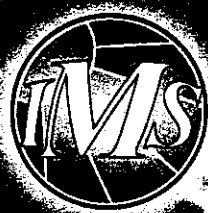
3. Submit one copy of the revised final printed label for the record before you release the product for shipment.

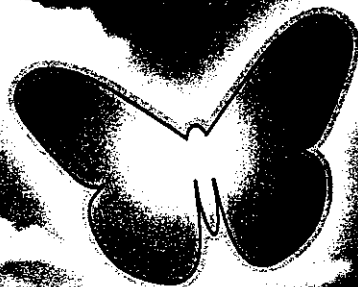
