- 4. Revise the third sentence by replacing the word Paradichlorbenzene with "other" moth products.
- 5. Under Storage and Disposal, add: "If empty: Do not reuse this container. Place in trash or offer for recycling if available. If partially filled: Call your local solid waste agency or 1-800-CLEANUP for disposal instructions. Never place unused product down any indoor or outdoor drain."
