NOTE TO PHYSICIAN

Recommendations for Medical Treatment for Avermectin B., Acute Toxicity: Early signs of intoxication include dilation of pupils, muscular incoordination, and tremors. Toxicity following accidental ingestion of the technical product can be minimized by including vomiting within one-half hour of exposure.

If toxicity from exposure has progressed to cause severe vomiting, the extent of resultant fluid and electrolyte imbalance should be gauged. Appropriate supportive measures (such as maintenance of blood pressure levels) as indicated by clinical signs, symptoms, and measurements.

In severe cases, observations should continue for at least several days until clinical condition is stable and normal. Since avermectin B₁ is believed to enhance GABA activity in animals, it is probably wise to avoid drugs that enhance GABA activity (barbiturates, benzodiazepines, valproic acid) in patients with potentially toxic avermectin B₁ exposure.
