- 3. Make the labeling changes listed below before you release the product for shipment:
 - a. Add the phrase "EPA Registration Number 81857-1".
 - **b**. The ingredient statements must total 100.00%.
 - c. Change the word "INACTIVE INGREDIENT" to "INERT INGREDIENTS or OTHER INGREDIENTS."
 - d. Revise the precautionary statements to read as follow:

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENT HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS CAUTION

Causes moderate eye irritation. Avoid contact with eyes. Wash Thoroughly with soap and water after handling.

e. Add the following heading and instructions to the label:

PHYSICAL OR CHEMICAL HAZARDS

Do not mix/use with bleach or mildew stain removers as irritating fumes may occur.

f. Revise the first aid statements to reads as follows:
