- d. Revise the first aid advisory statement to read:

- e. Add the signal word "**DANGER**" to the precautionary statement heading so that it read as follows:

- f. Add the following heading above the storage and disposal instructions:

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

- g. The Active Ingredient and Inert Ingredient (or Other Ingredient) heading must be given the same type size, aligned to the same margin and equally prominent. Refer to 40 CFR 156.10(g).
