It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

General:

Weed Spray No. 1 Concentrate is a non-selective weed killer active against all soft plant tissue it comes in contact with, including broadleaf and grassy weeds as well as desirable plants. Do not allow contact with desirable plants or vegetables. Weed Spray No. 1 Concentrate works fast. Soon after spraying, the foliage of treated weeds begins to whither and dies. If plant roots are not killed, new foliage may grow from the roots of perennial weeds; however, annual weeds with small root systems will die back completely. Retreatment is required for control of established perennial weeds.

Areas of Use:

Weed Spray No. 1 Concentrate may be used to control weed growth in non-crop areas such as railroad rights-of-way, power stations, industrial sites, around buildings, around storage areas, around tanks, borders, yards, vacant lots, driveways, sidewalks, around mature tree bases, around landscaped areas and golf courses, in fencerows and around flowerbeds. Do not spray growing crops, flowers, shrubs or lawns.

Weeds Controlled:

Annual Broadleaf Weeds such as:

Black medic, Chickweed, Cinquefoil, Cocklebur, Crotalaria, Curled dock, Fleabane species, Ivy Leaf Morning Glory, Lambsquarters, Mustard species, Oxalis species, Pigweed species, Ragweed species, Sicklepod, Velvetleaf.

Perennial Broadleaf Weeds such as:

Cinquefoil (silvery), Clover species, Dandelion, Plantain species, Toadflax, Tufted vetch, Wild carrot.

Annual Grasses such as:

Crabgrass, Foxtail species.

Perennial Grasses such as:

Bluegrass, Quack grass.

Other:

Algae, Liverwort, Mosses.

Application Directions:

Apply directly as a COARSE spray. Apply so that weed leaves and stems are fully wetted to the point of runoff. Thorough coverage is necessary for control. Repeat treatment if new growth of leaves appears.

Best results are achieved against tender, small weeds less than 4-inches high. Ideally spray in the spring and repeat as necessary over the growing season. Sowing or planting may occur as soon as the weeds begin to wither.

Mix 1 gallon of Weed Spray No. 1 Concentrate with 3 gallons of clean water. Half fill the spray tank with clean water. Add the required amount of Weed Spray No. 1 Concentrate. Fill tank with the remaining clean water to the required level. Agitate thoroughly before application. For spot treatments, use a single nozzle or handgun applicator to direct spray and thoroughly wet foliage. For broadcast applications, use flat fan nozzles and sufficient pressure to achieve thorough coverage.

Do not apply this product through any type of irrigation system. Do not allow contact with desirable plants.

Weather:

Apply **Weed Spray No. 1 Concentrate** on a dry day when rain is not expected for at least 4 hours. Rain shortly after spraying will reduce product effectiveness.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage or disposal.

PESTICIDE STORAGE: Store in original containers in a cool, dry area.

PESTICIDE DISPOSAL: Wastes resulting from the use of this product may be disposed of on site or at an approved waste disposal facility.

CONTAINER DISPOSAL: Triple rinse (or equivalent). Then offer for recycling or dispose in a sanitary landfill, or incineration, if allowed by state and local authorities by burning. Stay out of smoke.
