

On the basis of information furnished by the registrant, the above named pesticide is hereby registered under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide and Rodenticide Act. Registration is in no way to be construed as an endorsement or recommendation of this product by the Agency. In order to protect health and the environment, the Administrator, on his motion, may at any time suspend or cancel the registration of a pesticide in accordance with the Act. The acceptance of any name in connection with the registration of a product under this Act is not to be construed as giving the registrant a right to exclusive use of the name or to its use if it has been covered by others.

This product is conditionally registered in accordance with FIFRA sec. 3(c)(7)(A), provided that you make the following revisions:

1. Based on the acute toxicology profile for this product, the signal word should be, "Caution." Replace the current signal word wherever it appears on the label.
2. Modify the Precautionary Statements, Hazards to Humans and Domestic Animals text to read as follows: "Caution. Harmful if inhaled. Harmful if swallowed. Causes moderate eye irritation. Avoid breathing spray mist. Remove and wash contaminated clothing before reuse. Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling and before eating, drinking, chewing gum, or using tobacco. Avoid contact with eyes or clothing. Wear protective eyewear. Wear: Long-sleeved shirt and long pants, socks, shoes, and gloves.
3. Revise the First Aid statement as follows:
 - a. Move the "If inhaled" section to the top of the box, followed by the "If swallowed" section and then the "If in eyes" section. The "If on skin or clothing" section is optional, and may be deleted if so desired.
 - b. Modify the "If swallowed" section text as follows: Delete the statements beginning, "Immediately call a poison control center...", and, "Have person sip a glass...."
