



DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

PS Disinfecting Surface Wipes are non-woven disposable wipes pre-saturated with PS Disinfecting Surface Cleaner and are intended for use on hard, non-porous surfaces. PS Disinfecting Surface Wipes will clean and disinfect, when used as directed, such items as tables, chairs, counter tops, cabinets, lighters, telephones which are made of stainless steel, glass, Plexiglas®, and plastics (i.e., polycarbonate, polypropylene, polyvinylchloride, polystyrene). **DO NOT USE AS A BABY WIPE.**

Dispenser Directions:

To start feed, remove cover and discard seal. From center of wipe roll, pull up a wipe corner, twist it into a point and thread it through the hole in the container cover. **DO NOT PUSH FINGER THROUGH OPENING.** Replace lid and **PULL WIPE AT AN ANGLE.** The remaining wipes feed automatically, ready for next use. When not in use, keep center cap closed to prevent solution loss.

Cleaning and Disinfection Instructions:
