When used as directed, PS Disinfecting Bathroom Foam will clean and disinfect items such as: tubs, showers, basins, stainless steel, bath fixtures, inanimate surfaces, including those made of plastics (such as polycarbonate, polyvinylchloride, polypropylene and polystyrene), stainless steel, Plexiglas® glass and other hard non-porous surfaces.

***EFFECTIVE ON HARD, NON-POROUS, INANIMATE SURFACES AGAINST:** Pseudomonas aeruginosa, Staphylococcus aureus, Salmonella choleraesuis, Mycobacterium tuberculosis var bovis (BCG), Trichophyton mentagrophytes



SHAKE WELL BEFORE USING.

CLEANING INSTRUCTIONS: Hold dispenser 6" to 8" from surface to be cleaned. Spray surface thoroughly and wipe clean using a clean cloth or paper towel. Repeat as needed until surface is visibly clean.

DISINFECTING INSTRUCTIONS: Hold dispenser 6" to 8" from surface to be treated. Spray pre-cleaned surface thoroughly wetting area and allow to remain on surface for at least 10 minutes at room temperature. Follow by wiping surface dry using a clean cloth or paper towel.

FIRST AID
If in eyes: Hold eye open and rinse slowly and gently with water for 15-20 minutes. Remove contact lenses, if present, after the first 5 minutes, then continue rinsing. Call a poison control center or doctor for treatment advice.

If on skin or clothing: Take off contaminated clothing. Rinse skin immediately with plenty of water for 15-20 minutes. Call a poison control center or doctor for treatment advice.

If swallowed: Call a poison control center or doctor immediately for treatment advice. Have person sip a glass of water if able to swallow. Do not induce vomiting unless told to do so by a poison control center or doctor. Do not give anything by mouth to an unconscious person.

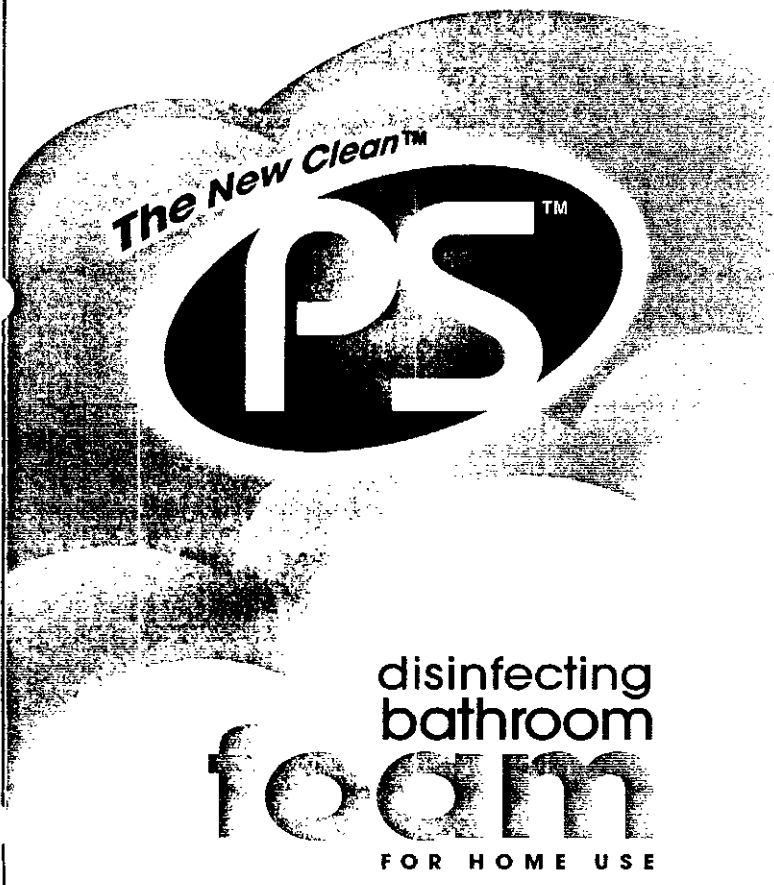
