

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

SURFACES: (Where appropriate, follow Universal Precautions.)

To CLEAN surfaces:

Apply PS Disinfection Surface Cleaner directly to surface. Allow to remain wet for 30 seconds. Wipe surface using a paper towel or cloth towel. Discard towel.

To DISINFECT surfaces:

Apply PS Disinfecting Surface Cleaner directly to pre-cleaned surface, thoroughly wetting area to be disinfecting. Allow surface to remain wet for 3 minutes at room temperature.

FIRST AID

If in eyes: Hold eye open and rinse slowly and gently with water for 15-20 minutes. Remove contact lenses, if present, after the first 5 minutes, then continue rinsing eye. Call a poison control center or doctor for treatment advice.

If on skin or clothing: Take off contaminated clothing. Rinse skin immediately with plenty of water for 15-20 minutes. Call a poison control center or doctor for further treatment advice.

If swallowed: Call a poison control center or doctor immediately for treatment advice. Have person sip a glass of water if able to swallow. Do not induce vomiting unless told to do so by a poison control center or doctor. Do not give anything by mouth to an unconscious person.

If inhaled: Move person to fresh air. If person is not breathing, call 911 or an ambulance, then give artificial respiration, preferably mouth-to-mouth, if possible. Call a poison control center or doctor for further treatment advice.

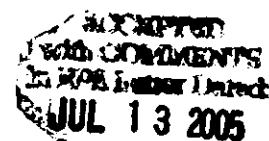
STORAGE AND DISPOSAL
