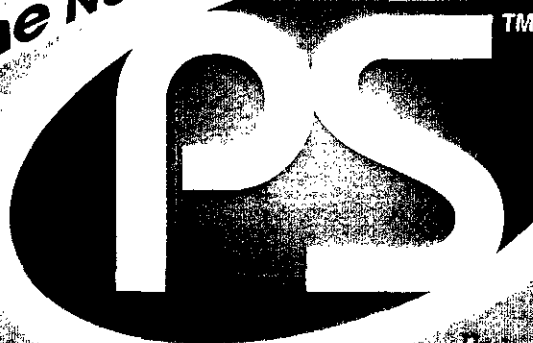

DESCRIPTION: PS Disinfecting Surface Cleaner is a multi-purpose disinfectant/decontaminant cleaner for use on hard, inanimate surfaces. PS Disinfecting Surface Cleaner will effectively clean and disinfect, when used as directed, such items as: tables, chairs, non-food countertops, cabinets, telephones, lamps which are made of metal, including those made of plastics (such as: polycarbonate, polyvinylchloride, polypropylene and polystyrene), non-porous vinyl, stainless steel, painted surfaces, Plexiglas®, glass, and other hard non-porous surfaces.

***EFFECTIVE AGAINST:** Mycobacterium tuberculosis var. bovis (BCG), Staphylococcus aureus, Pseudomonas aeruginosa, Salmonella choleraesuis, Trichophyton mentagrophytes, Methicillin Resistant Staphylococcus aureus (MRSA), Vancomycin Resistant Enterococcus faecalis (VRE), Hepatitis B (HBV), Hepatitis C Virus (HCV), Herpes simplex virus Types 1 and 2.



DIRECTIONS FOR USE: It is a violation

of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

SURFACES: (Where appropriate, follow Universal Precautions.)

To CLEAN surfaces: Apply PS Disinfecting Surface Cleaner directly to surface. Allow to remain wet for 30 seconds. Wipe surface using a paper towel or cloth towel. Discard towel.

To DISINFECT surfaces: Apply PS Disinfecting Surface Cleaner directly to pre-cleaned surface, thoroughly wetting area to be disinfected. Allow surface to remain wet for 3 minutes at room temperature. For tuberculocidal disinfection, allow the surface to remain visibly wet for 5 minutes at room temperature.

FIRST AID:

If in eyes: Hold eye open and rinse slowly and gently with water for 15-20 minutes. Remove contact lenses, if present, after the first 5 minutes, then continue rinsing eye. Call a poison control center or doctor for treatment advice.

If on skin or clothing: Take off contaminated clothing. Rinse skin immediately with plenty of water for 15-20 minutes. Call a poison control center or doctor for further treatment advice.

If swallowed: Call a poison control center or doctor immediately for treatment advice. Have person sip a glass of water if able to swallow. Do not induce vomiting unless told to do so by a poison control center or doctor. Do not give anything by mouth to an unconscious person.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL: Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage and disposal.

Pesticide Storage: Store in a cool place.

Pesticide Disposal: Wastes resulting from the use of this product may be disposed of according to applicable Federal, State, or local procedures.

Container Disposal: Triple rinse. Then offer for recycling or reconditioning, or puncture and dispose of in a sanitary landfill, or incineration or, if allowed by state and local authorities, by burning. If burned, keep out of smoke.
