Your submission dated September 17, 2005

The amendment referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under FIFRA section 3(c)(7)(a), is acceptable provided that you:

1. Submit and/or cite all data or other material required for registration/reregistration of your product under FIFRA section 3(c)(5) or FIFRA section 4 when the Agency requires all registrants of similar products to submit such data.
2. Make the labeling changes listed below before you release the product for shipment bearing the amended labeling:
  - a) On the front panel add "precautions" to the referral statement i.e., "Read the directions and precautions for use on back panel."
  - b) Revise the disposal statement to read "Discard used mattress liner in trash."
  - c) Under Important add, "Do not use for purposes other than as a mattress liner."
  - d) Add the following statement to the front panel, "Retain This Package Label for Future Reference on Proper Handling of This Mattress Liner."
  - e) Revise the referral statement on the mattress liner tag label to read as follows: "See package label for complete directions and precautions for use."
  - f) Add the EPA Establishment Number and disposal statement "Discard used mattress liner in trash." to the mattress liner tag label.
  - g) Add a use statement such as "Kills dust mites in mattress for up to two (2) years" to the mattress liner tag label.

3. Submit three (3) copies of your final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment.

If these conditions are not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA section 6(e). Your release for shipment of the product constitutes acceptance of these conditions.

A stamped copy of the label is enclosed for your records.
