Subject: Notification of Additional Alternate Brand Name per PR Notice 98-10 for Turf and Garden Seven % Granular Carbaryl Insecticide; EPA Reg. No. 82200 – 1

Dear Ms. Arrington:

Enclosed please find a Notification for an additional alternate brand name and product label for the subject product, Turf and Garden Seven % Granular Carbaryl Insecticide, EPA Reg. No. 82200 – 1. This change is being submitted in accordance with the procedures and requirements of PR Notice 98-10.

In addition to a second alternate brand name, this Notification has incorporated the most recent label revisions required by EPA during the past year for the registered product label, the amended final draft version of which was submitted to EPA on January 26, 2010. Similarly to our initial alternate brand notification of April 4, 2008, all uses except the use to kill ticks have been deleted, creating a specialty product label limited to a single use (ticks).

With only a single use, "To Kill Ticks Which May Vector Lyme Disease", retained from the original registered label, minor changes to the use directions text have been made for clarification purposes. These include adding "Residential Lawns" as the major heading for the use directions and adding a reference to the directions to apply the product uniformly to dry grass using a spreader, both taken from the "Residential Lawns" section of the full registered label. The full registered and recently amended final draft product label is unchanged.

The required EPA Form 8570–1, one copy of the draft "redlined" alternate brand name product label highlighting the changes and additions and two copies of the "clean" final draft label are attached. Your efforts in assuring the prompt review of this notification are greatly appreciated. Thank you for your attention in this matter.

#### NOTE TO PHYSICIAN

Carbaryl is a N-methyl carbamate insecticide, which is a cholinesterase inhibitor. Atropine is antidotal. Narcotics and other sedatives should not be used. Further, drugs like 2-PAM (pyridine-2-aldoxime methiodide) are NOT recommended.

Consultation on diagnosis, therapy and analysis can be obtained at all hours by calling the emergence number.

Avoid contact with eyes, skin or clothing. Wear long-sleeved shirt, long pants, shoes plus socks and chemical resistant gloves when handling this product. Change clothing as soon as possible after use. Wash the outside of gloves before removing. Wash hands thoroughly with soap and water immediately after handling and before eating, drinking, chewing gum, using tobacco, or using the toilet. Remove and wash contaminated clothing before reuse. 

Turf and Garden Tick Destroy•R Seven Percent Granular Carbaryl Insecticide is a granular formulation of carbaryl that may be applied by a properly calibrated push type spreader.

Do not apply product by hand, spoon or by using a belly grinder.

Apply when air is calm. For plants above chest height, consider using a liquid carbaryl product.

Do not apply this product in a way that will contact any person or pet, either directly or through drift.

Keep people and pets out of the area during application.

Do not allow people or pets to enter treated area until dusts have settled.

Product must be watered in immediately following application to lawns.

Do not allow people (except those involved in watering-in) or pets to enter the treated area until the watering-in is completed and the area has dried.

Not for use on plants grown for sale or commercial use, research, or commercial seed production. For outdoor use only.

Application to wet foliage or during periods of high humidity may cause injury to tender foliage.

# RESIDENTIAL LAWNS To Kill Ticks Which May Vector Lyme Disease

To kill juvenile and adult *Ixodes spp.* ticks (Deer tick, Bear tick, and Black legged tick) and *Amblyomma spp.* ticks (Lone star tick), apply granules uniformly to dry grass using a spreader at the rate of 2.8 pounds of formulated product per 1000 square feet. Will only kill ticks that are present at the time of application. Ticks must be directly contacted to be effective.

Begin applications in late spring or early summer (May/June). Apply the product uniformly across the entire lawn, perimeter wooded areas, and property boundaries including shrub beds, ornamental plantings, and wooded areas where exposure to ticks may occur. Irrigate treated areas immediately after application to remove chemical from granules. Repeat applications as needed up to a total of 4 times per year. Do not apply more often than once every week.
