Dear Mr. Jacoby:

The labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA), as amended, is acceptable subject to the comments listed below. Two (2) copies of the finished labeling must be submitted prior to releasing the product for shipment. A stamped copy of the label is enclosed for your records.

1. The label statement "*Garments may be laundered with other clothing when in field or combat situations*" is acceptable for military treated apparel only.
2. Correct the EPA Registration Number on the hand tag to read 82392-1.
3. Delete "*fabric*" throughout the label. The term fabric is too generic a term.

Please note that a notice of availability of EPA's reregistration eligibility document (RED) for products containing permethrin was published in the FR on June 28, 2006 (Vol 71 no. 124 pg. 36788). Additional data and/or labeling changes may be required for products containing permethrin.
