On behalf of Summit Agro (USA) Corporation (600 Third Avenue, New York, NY 10016-2001), Exponent, Inc. is submitting a notification pursuant to PR Notice 98-10 to revise the label for the registered product Triforine Technical to reflect Summit Agro (USA) Corporation as the current registrant. Summit Agro recently purchased Triforine Technical from BASF and the changes to the enclosed label are being made to reflect Summit Agro (USA) Corporation as the current registrant and to make minor changes to the content of the label. The following changes were made to the label: change the company name, EPA registration number, and EPA establishment number, revise the Net Contents statement to add the US measurement (lbs), and revise the emergency hot line telephone number replacing BASF's telephone number with Chemtrec.
