

2. On page 1 add the company's telephone number underneath the address. Also on page 1 fill in the "Net Contents" quantity (e.g., quarts, gallons, etc.).
3. On page 3 under the heading "Warranty Statement" revise the last sentence to read: "... seller, and ...to the extent consistent with applicable law, the buyer assumes the risk of any such use".
4. Within eighteen months of the date of this registration, submit to the Agency the required one year storage stability study (830.6317) for the proposed product under warehouse conditions. The corrosion characteristics study (830.6320) may be carried out concurrently. It is recommended that observations be made at 0, 3, 6, 9, and 12 months be submitted within the 18 month timeframe. **Provided the above required data is submitted by the holder of the parent registration the above requirement for this registration will not be necessary by Source Dynamics LLC.**
5. Submit two copies of your final printed label before you release the product for shipment. If these conditions are not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA section 6(e).
