Dear Ms Wagner:

The amended label referred to above, resubmitted August 15, 2008 in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide and Rodenticide Act as amended is acceptable provided the last sentence on page 4 is revised to read "... and to the extent consistent with applicable law, the buyer assumes the risk of any such use."

As a condition of registration, you must submit or cite data to satisfy the following data gaps in the timeframe specified below:

1. Submit barley field trial data from regions 10 and 11 (along with concurrent storage stability data on barley straw). Submission Due by: December 2011
2. Comply in the timeframe specified with the future Agency Data Call-in for all triazole-derivative active ingredients.
3. Submit a Whole Sediment Toxicity Study for benthic invertebrates. Submission due by: December 2011.
4. Submit Aerobic and Anaerobic Aquatic Metabolism Studies. Submission due by: December 2011.

One copy of the label stamped "Accepted with comments" is enclosed for your records. Submit one copy of the final printed label before the product is released for shipment.
