



# STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Container Disposal: Nonrefillable container. Do not refill or reuse container. Triple rinse as follows: Empty the remaining contents into application equipment or a mix tank. Fill the container ¼ full with water. Replace and tighten closures. Tip container on its side and roll it back and forth, ensuring at least one complete revolution, for 30 seconds. Stand the container on its end and tip it back and forth several times. Turn the container over onto its other end and tip it back and forth several times. Empty the rinsate into application equipment or a mix tank or store rinsate for later use or disposal. Repeat this procedure two more times. Offer for recycling or reconditioning, or puncture and dispose of in a sanitary landfill or by other procedures approved by state and local authorities.

This product is intended only for the formulation of other Tebuconazole fungicide products. Products formulated using Tebuconazole Technical will require registration with the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency. Labeling for products formulated from this product must conform to that which is currently registered with the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency. Any variance from federally registered labeling for products containing tebuconazole will have to be supported by data provided by the formulator.


