The amended labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act, as amended, is acceptable.

This approval does not affect any terms or conditions that were previously imposed on this registration. You continue to be subject to existing terms or conditions on your registration and any deadlines connected with them.

A stamped copy of your labeling is enclosed for your records. This labeling supersedes all previously accepted labeling. You must submit one (1) copy of the final printed labeling before you release this product for shipment with the new labeling. In accordance with 40 CFR § 152.130(c), you may distribute or sell this product under the previously approved labeling for 18 months from the date of this letter. After 18 months, you may only distribute or sell this product if it bears this new revised labeling or subsequently approved labeling. "To distribute or sell" is defined under FIFRA section 2(gg) and its implementing regulation at 40 CFR § 152.3.

Should you wish to add/retain a reference to your company's website on your label, then please be aware that the website becomes labeling under FIFRA and is subject to review by EPA. If the website is false or misleading, the product will be considered to be misbranded and sale or distribution of the product is unlawful under FIFRA section 12(a)(1)(E). 40 CFR § 156.10(a)(5) lists examples of statements the EPA may consider false or misleading. NOTE TO PHYSICIAN

To be effective, treatment for diquat poisoning must begin IMMEDIATELY. Treatment consists of binding diquat in the gut with suspensions of activated charcoal or bentonite clay, administration of cathartics to enhance elimination, and removal of diquat from the blood by charcoal hemoperfusion or continuous hemodialysis.

If in eyes, treat symptomatically. Symptoms may develop gradually. Severe damage may be caused by apparently trivial contact and healing may be delayed. Medical supervision should be continued until healing is complete.

Sharda Diquat Concentrate is intended solely for the formulation into herbicide products intended for the following uses:

Terrestrial Food Use: Canola, Potato Harvest Aid

Terrestrial Uses: Seed Crops (Alfalfa, Clover, Grain sorghum, Soybeans), Non-Bearing Grapes and certain non-bearing trees, Vines, Small fruits and Vegetable crops; Areas around Farms: Fence Lines, Farmyards, Farm Buildings, Fuel Storage Areas, Rights-of-way, Barrier Strips, Equipment Areas, and Non-Flooded Portions of Ponds, Lakes and Ditches around Farms; Rights-of-way, including Railroads, Highways, Roads, Dividers and Medians, Pipelines, Public Utility Lines, Pumping Stations, Transformer Stations and Substations; Commercial, Landscape, Industrial, Recreational, Residential and Public areas including around Electric Utilities, Commercial Buildings, Manufacturing Plants, Storage Yards, Rail Yards, Fence Lines and Parkways, Edges and Non-Flooded Portions of Ponds, Lakes and Ditches; Rights-of-way including Dividers and Medians, Highways, Pipelines, Public utility lines, Pumping stations. CONTAINER DISPOSAL**

Refillable container. Refill this container with pesticide only. Do not reuse this container for any other purpose. To clean the container before final disposal, empty the remaining contents from this container into application equipment or mix tank. Fill the container about 10 percent full with water. Agitate vigorously or recirculate water with the pump for 2 minutes. Pour or pump rinsate into application equipment or rinsate collection system. Repeat this rinsing procedure two more times.

CONTAINER PRECAUTIONS

Before refilling, inspect thoroughly for damage, such as cracks, punctures, bulges, dents, abrasions, and damaged or worn threads on closure devices.

REFILL ONLY WITH SHARDA DIQUAT CONCENTRATE

The contents of this container cannot be completely removed by cleaning. Refilling with materials other than Sharda Diquat Concentrate will result in contamination and may weaken the container. Check for leaks after filling and before transporting. Do not refill or transport a damaged or leaking container.
