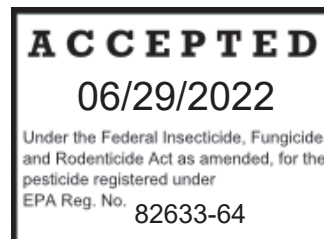

- All wettable powders (WP) formulations must be packaged in water soluble packaging.

**[Nonrefillable Container (rigid material; 5 gallons or greater):** Nonrefillable container. Do not reuse or refill this container. Offer for recycling, if available. Clean container promptly after emptying. Triple rinse as follows: Empty the remaining contents into application equipment or a mix tank. Fill the container ¼ full with water. Stand the container on its end and tip it back and forth several times. Turn the container over onto its other end and tip it back and forth several times. Repeat this procedure two more times.
