DIRECTIONS FOR USE

EZ-Root Gel is a thick gel used to propagate new plants from stem and leaf cuttings. EZ-Root Gel is formulated with an essential hormone that promotes rapid root generation and growth. EZ-Root Gel may be used on any type of cutting, including woody, herbaceous, and flowering ornamental species, vegetables, fruit trees, and small fruits.

TAKING CUTTINGS:

Take cuttings only from new growth on healthy plants. Trim cuttings to 2-8 inch pieces. Make cuts at a 45-degree angle. **Do not dip cuttings into container. Do not pour used gel back into the container.** Immediately dip into EZ-Root Gel, or immerse in water until ready to be dipped. The cuttings can also be re-cut prior to dipping. Spray cuttings frequently, and use a humidity dome to prevent excessive wilting.

APPLICATION INSTRUCTIONS:

First empty a small amount of EZ-Root Gel into a separate container. **Do not dip plants directly into the bottle.** Dip the cut end of the stem into EZ-Root Gel to desired depth. After EZ-Root Gel has been applied, place cuttings into the rooting medium. Depending on the species, rooting will take place in days, weeks, or months under optimal environments. Transplanting may be performed once the cuttings have rooted.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal

Pesticide Storage: Store only in original container, in a cool dry place out of the reach of children and out of direct sunlight.

Pesticide Disposal and Container Handling: Non-refillable container. Do not reuse or refill this container. If empty: place in trash or offer for recycling if available.
