Historical monitoring of the site, previous records or experiences, current season adult trapping or other methods should be used to determine the need for an application. Best results occur when applications are made prior to egg hatch of the target pest followed by sufficient irrigation or rainfall to move the active ingredient through the thatch with optimum control if irrigation or rainfall occurs within 24 hours of application to move the active ingredient through the thatch.
