AGROSAN PLUS ACID SANITIZER

DANGER: CORROSIVE. Causes eye irreversible damage or skin burns. Harmful if swallowed, absorbed through skin or inhaled. Do not get into eyes, on skin, or on clothing. Avoid breathing spray mist. Wear goggles or face shield. Wear protective clothing and rubber gloves. Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling and before eating, drinking, chewing gum, using tobacco or using the toilet. Remove contaminated clothing and wash contaminated clothing before reuse.

ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS: (5 gallons or greater)

Do not rinse or clean. Seal tote and contact AgroChem USA, LLC for return.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

For Dairy and Food Processing Equipment, Tanks, Vats, Pails, Pipelines and Closed Systems - An effective sanitizer against Escherichia coli (ATCC 11229) and Staphylococcus aureus (ATCC# 6538). For use on stainless steel and hard non-porous food contact surfaces. Clean all surfaces thoroughly with proper detergent and rinse with water. Sanitize equipment prior to use. Use immersion, circulation or coarse spray sanitizing techniques as appropriate. For sanitizing by immersion or circulation, use AGROSAN PLUS at 1 ounce to 6 gallons of water. For coarse spray sanitizing use AGROSAN PLUS at 1 ounce to 3 gallons of water. All surfaces must be exposed to the sanitizing solution for a period of 2 minutes.
